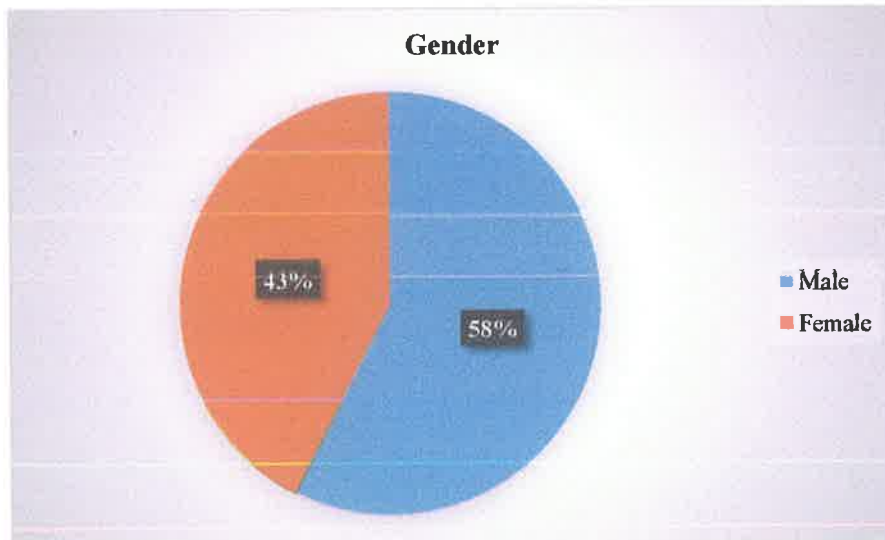

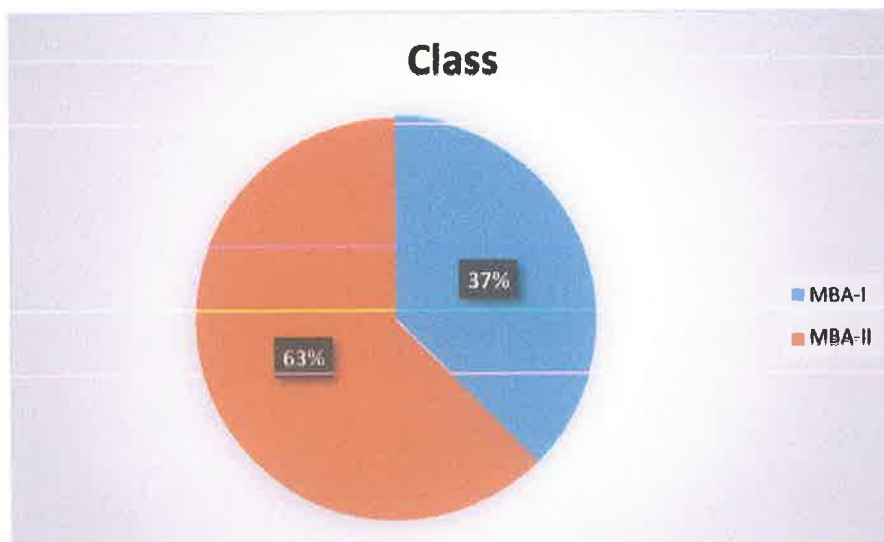

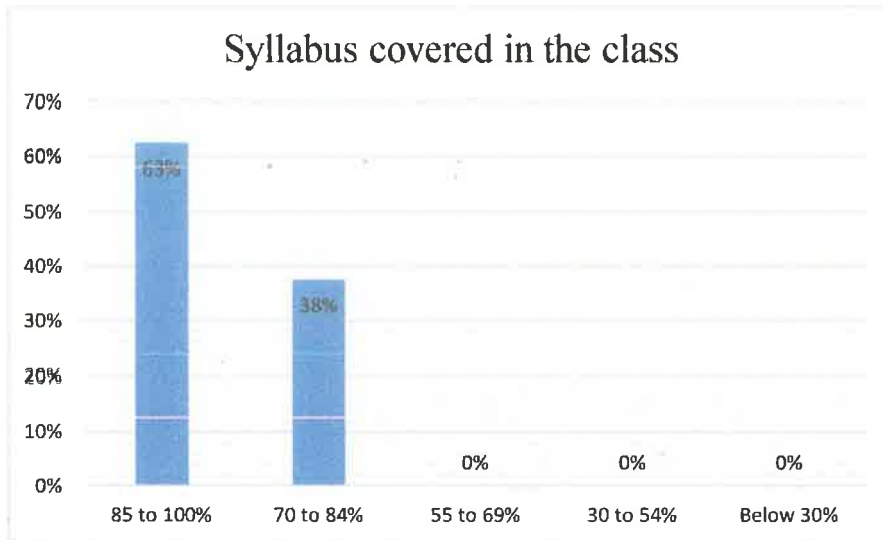


Interpretation: The above graph states that, 58% boys and 43% girls have submitted this SSS.

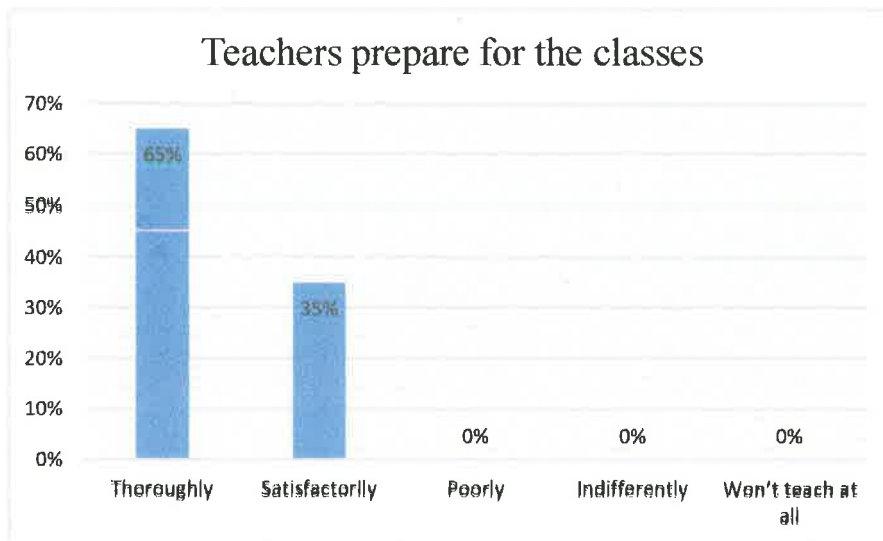


Interpretation: The above graph states that, 63% students are from class MBA-II and 37% are from MBA-I.



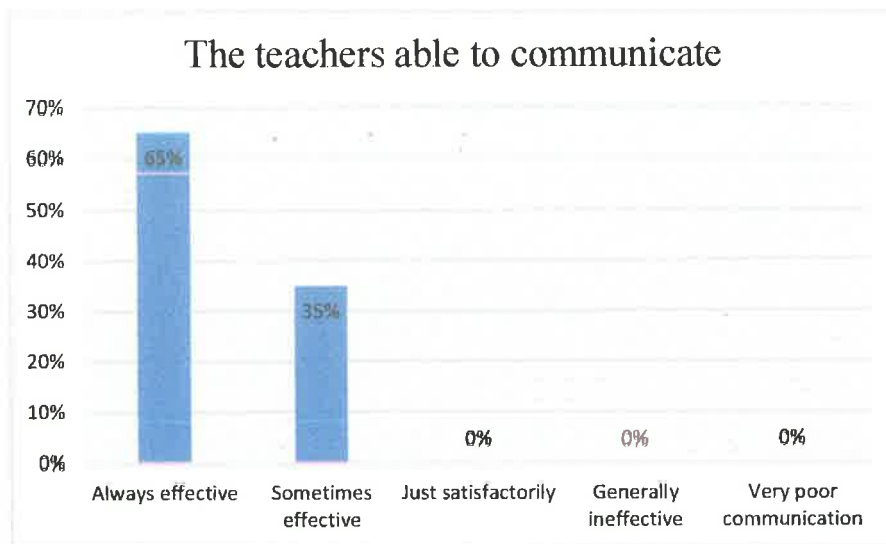

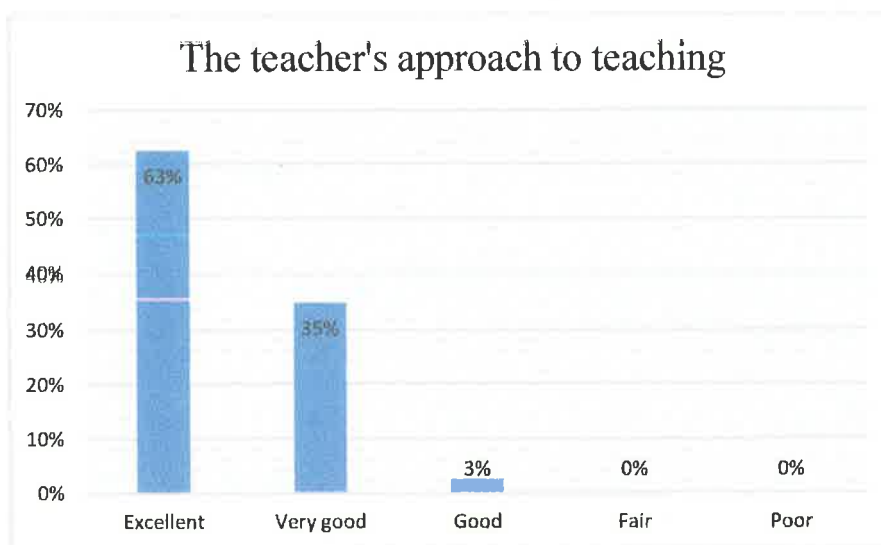

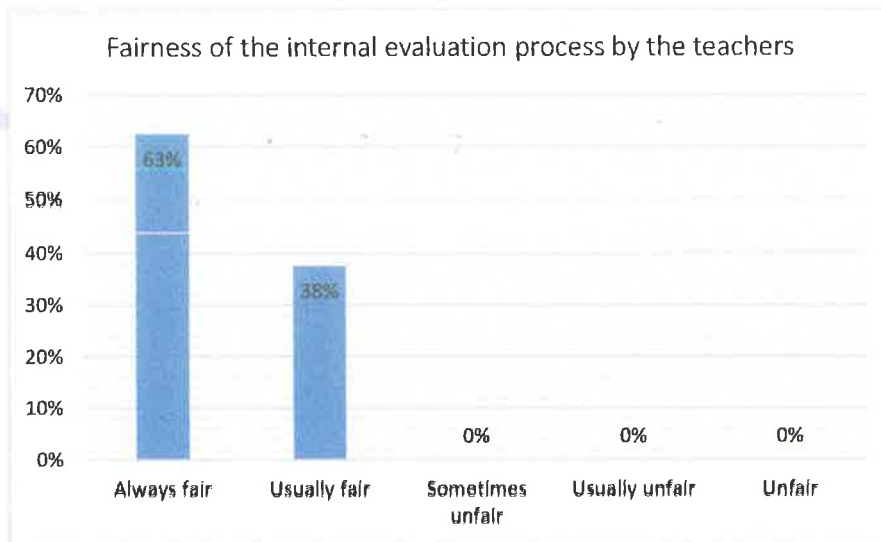

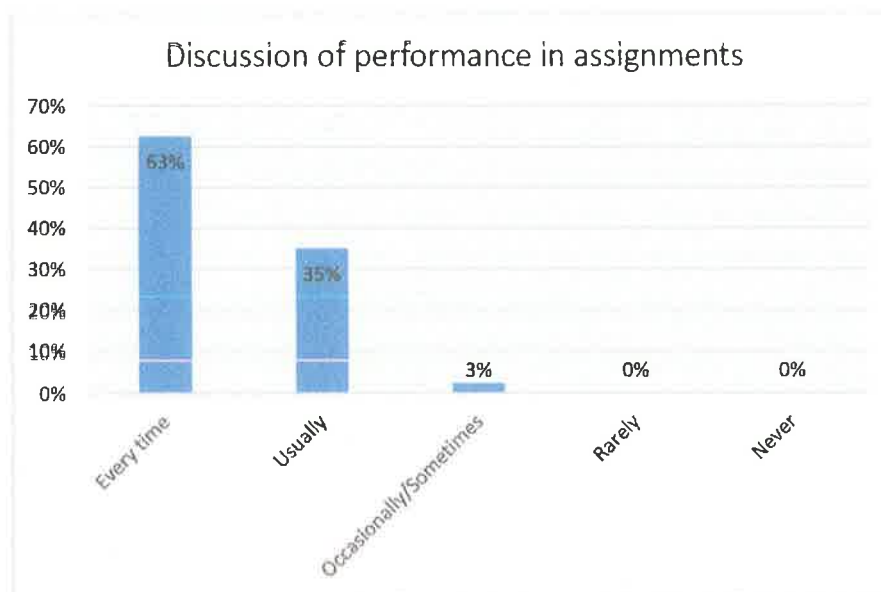

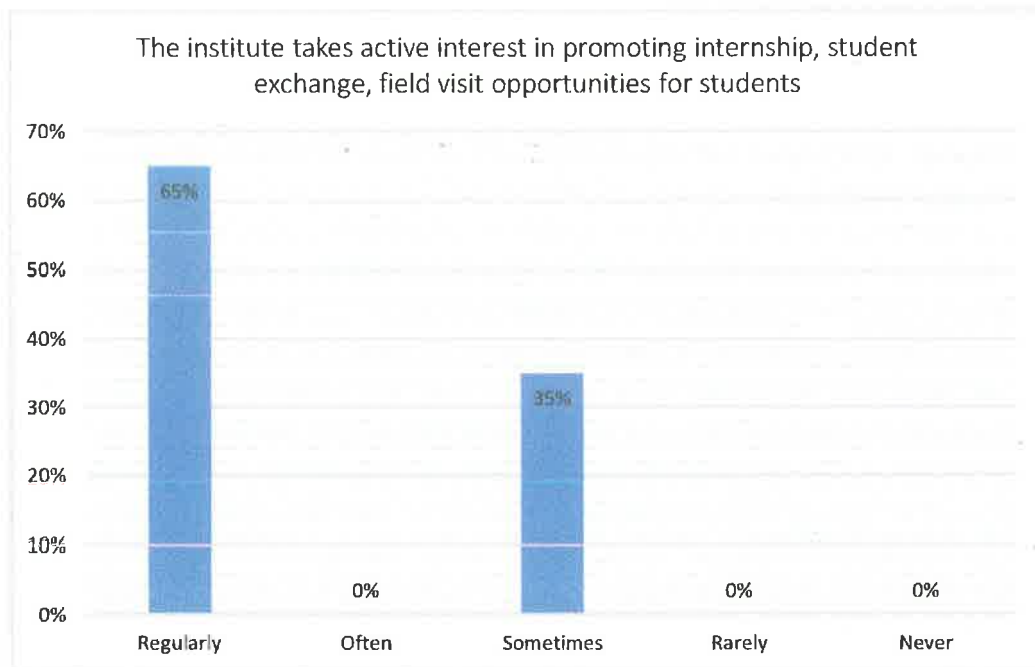

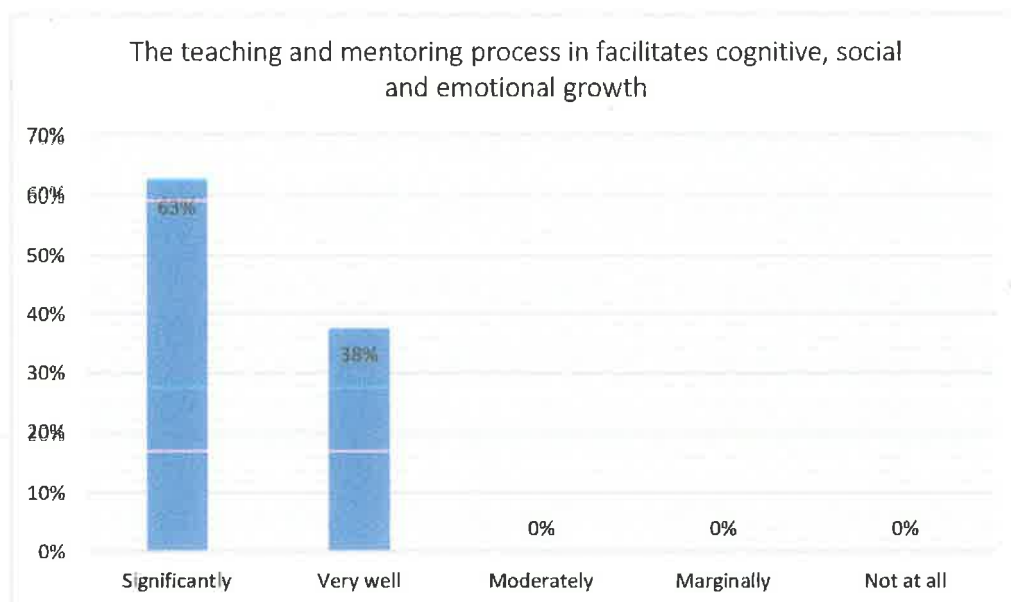

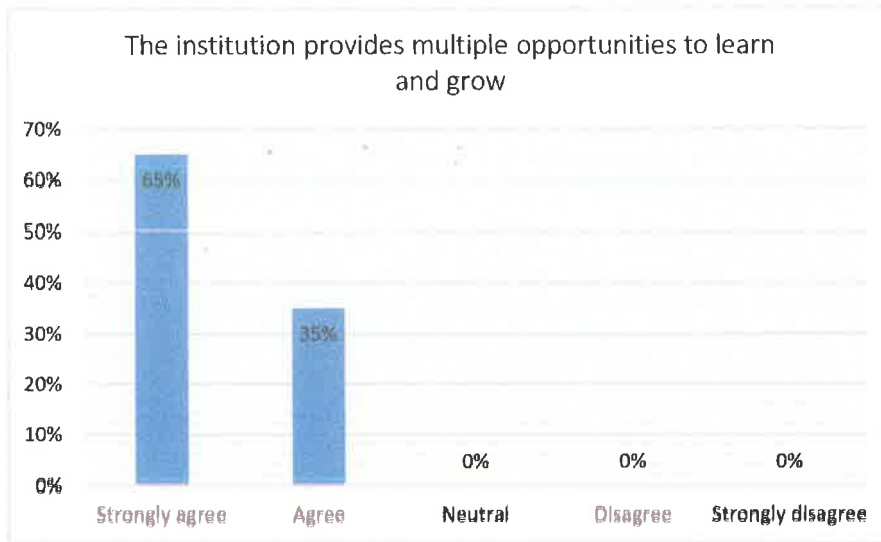

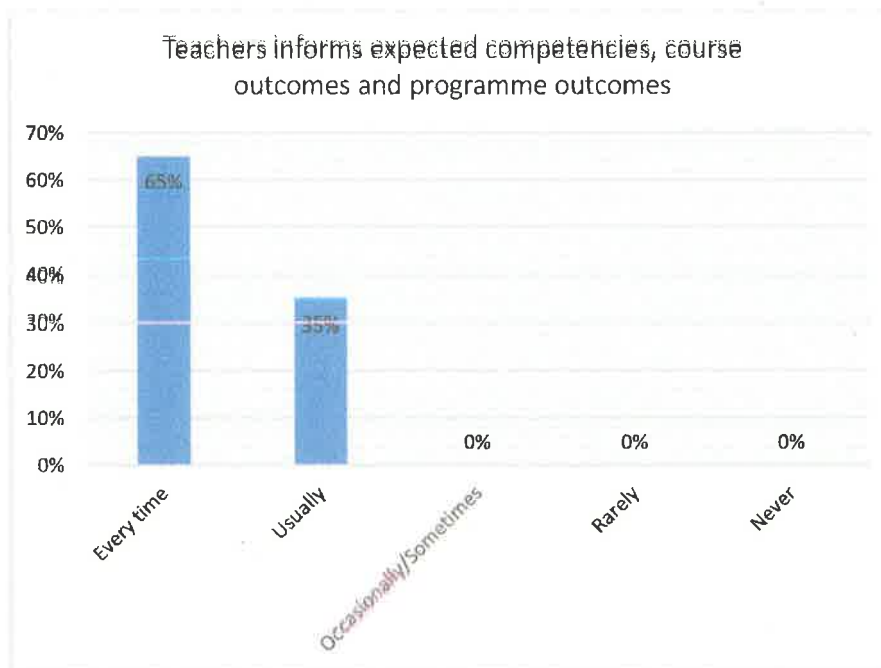

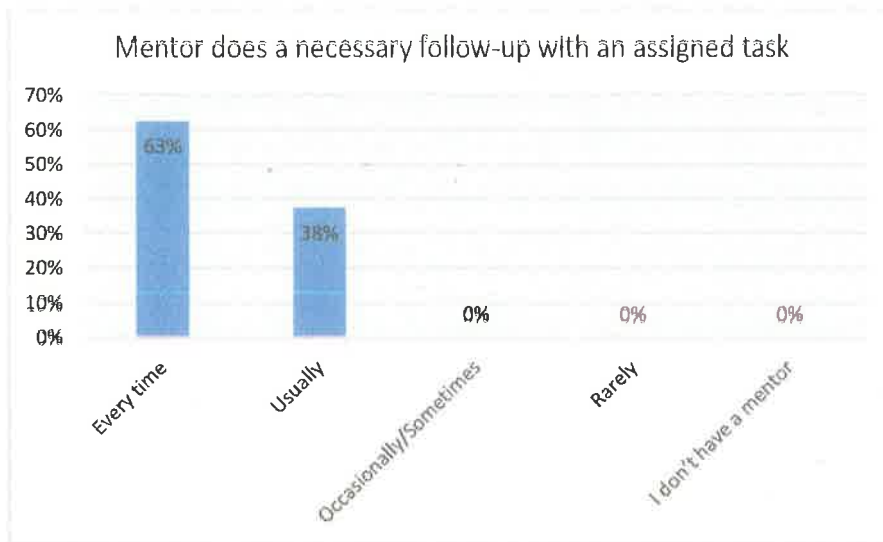

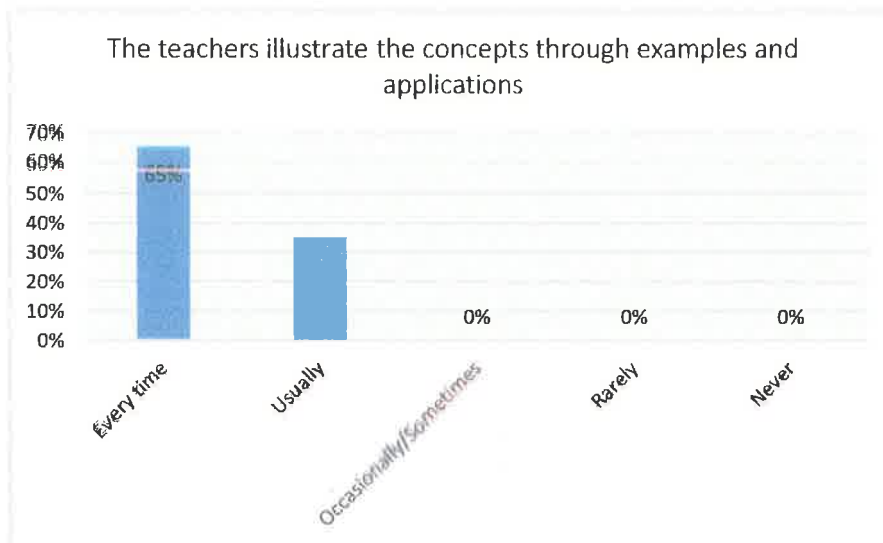

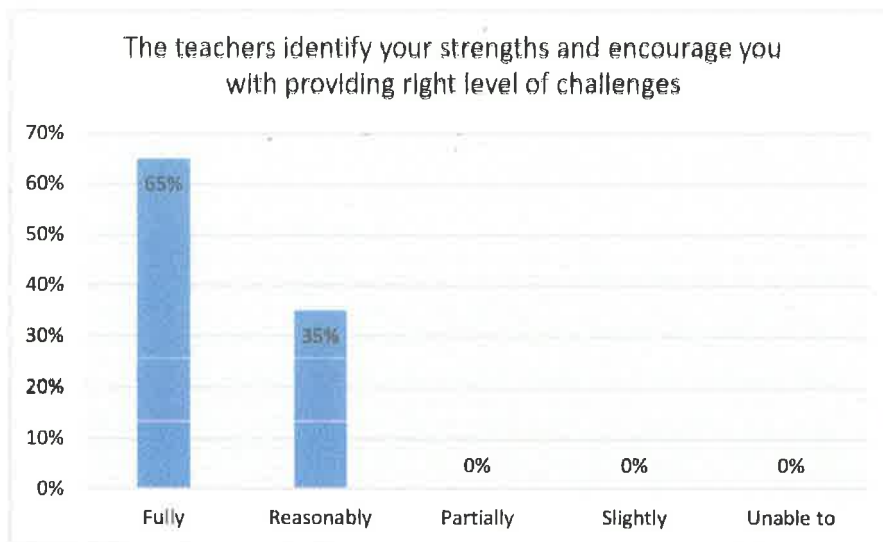

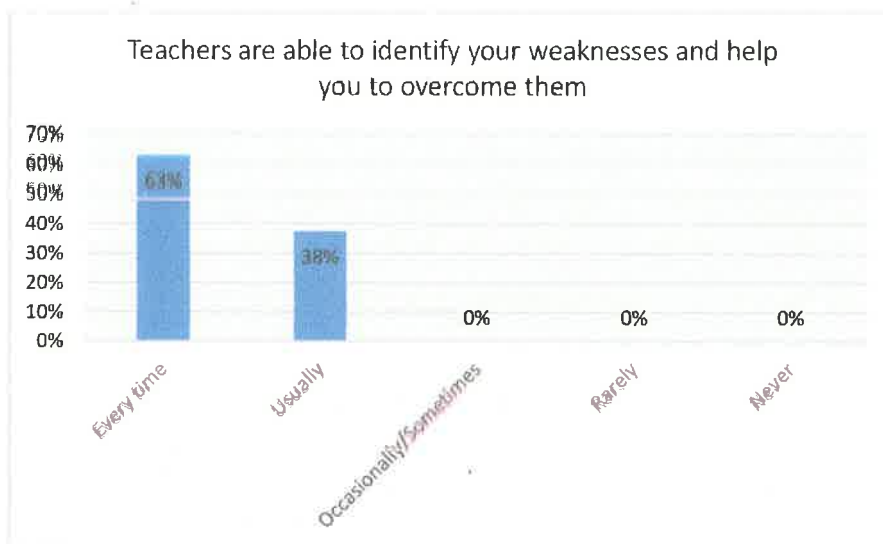

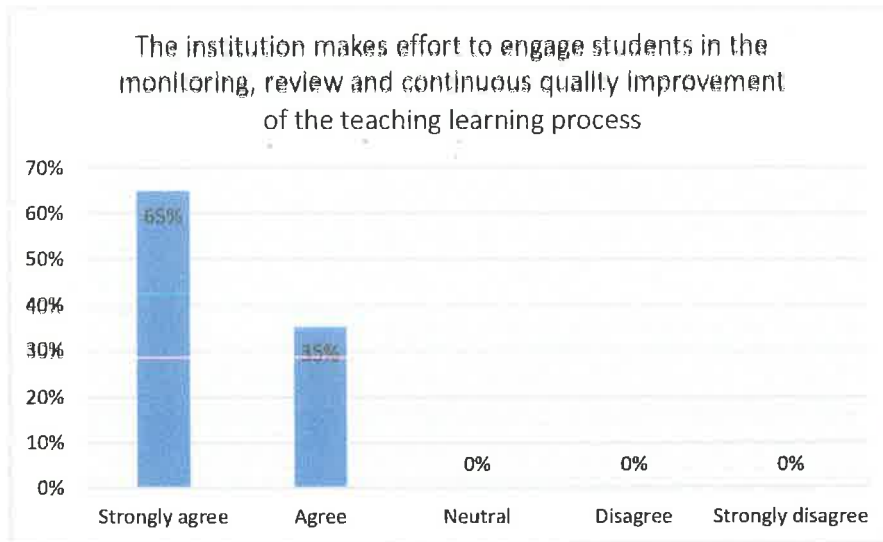

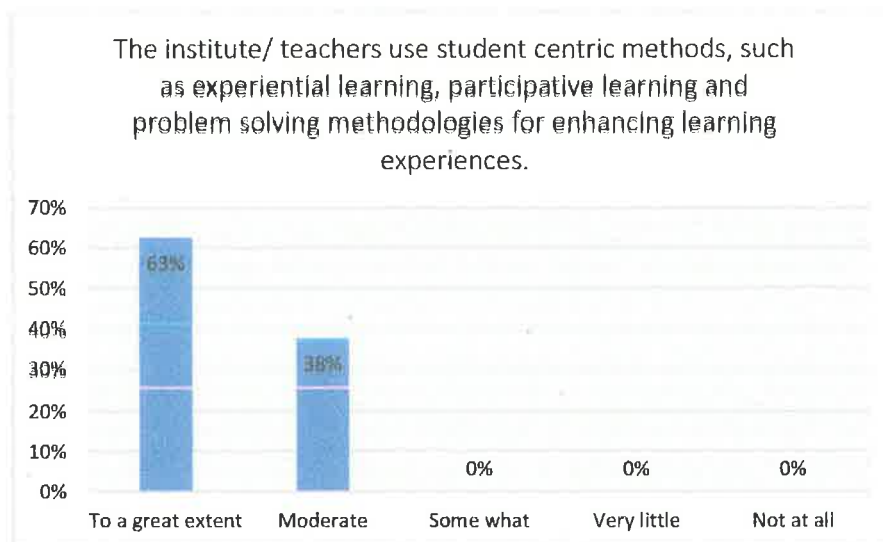

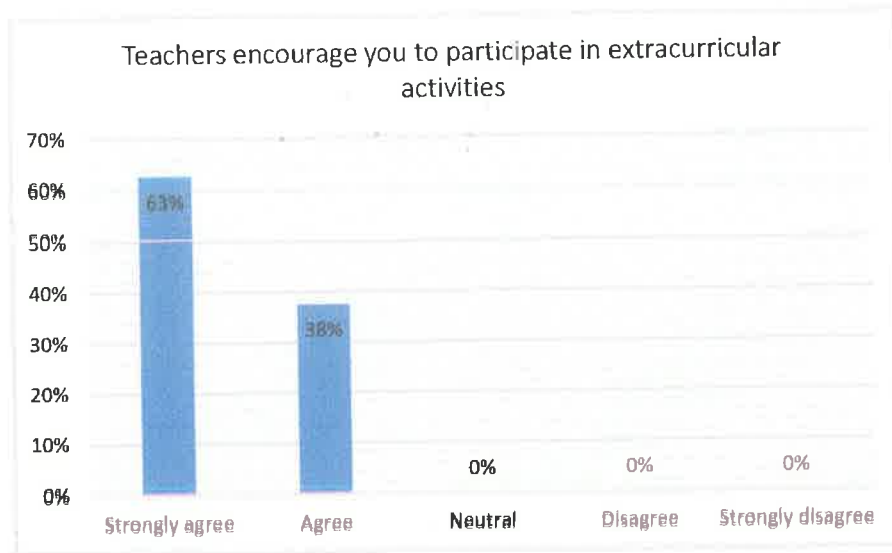

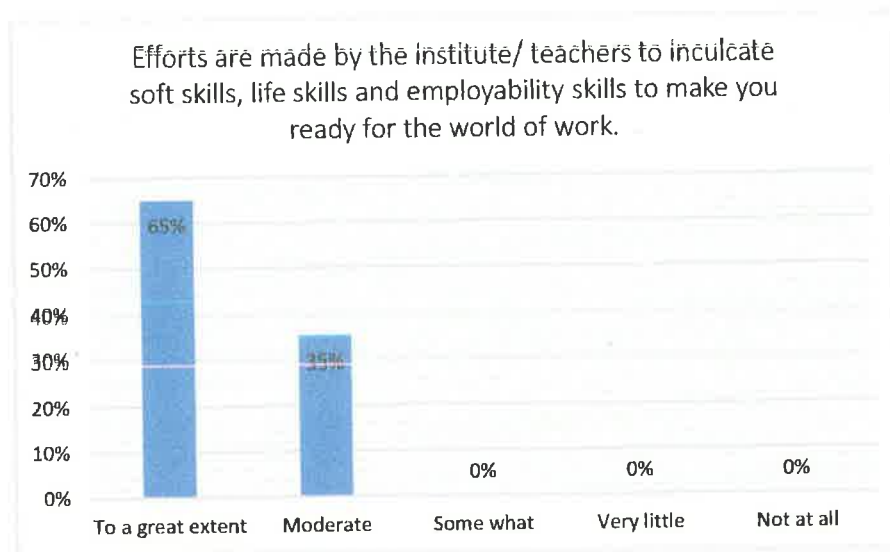

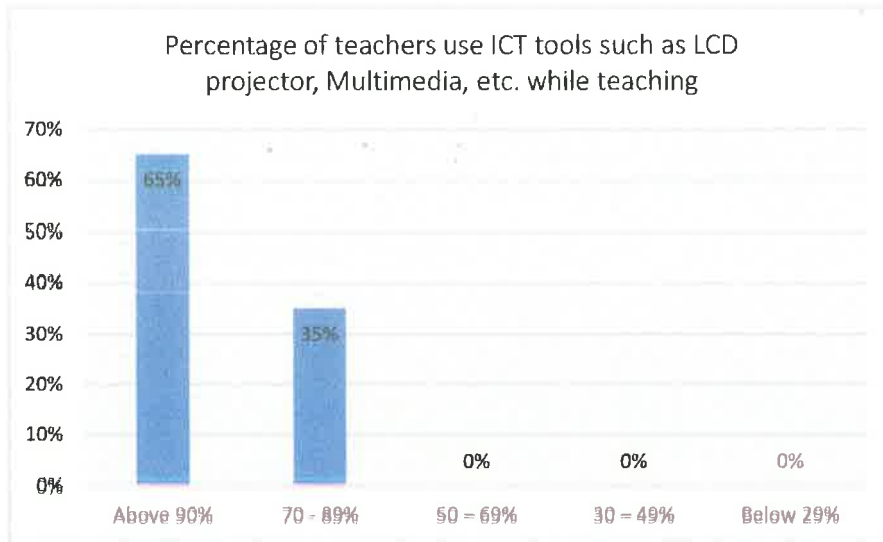

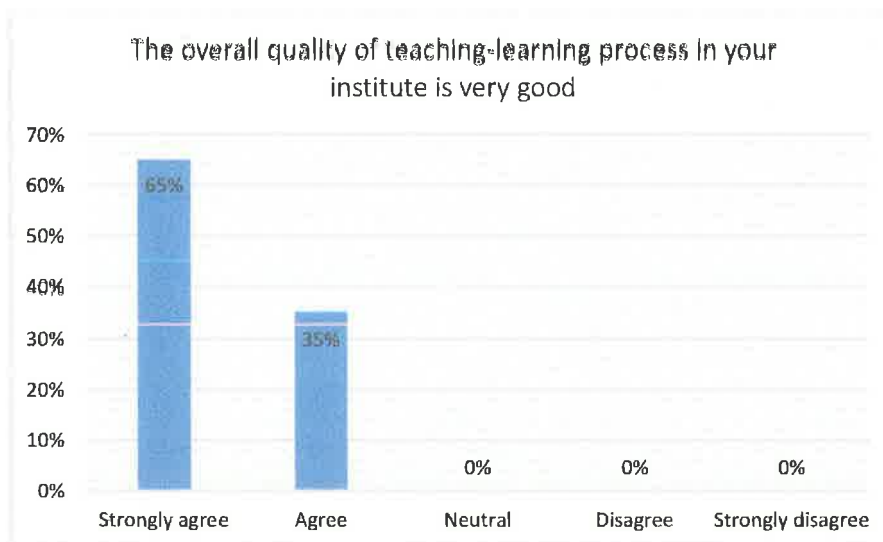
