A Report of Feedback for the Academic Year 2020-21

A feedback on design and review of syllabus was collected from Students, Teachers, Employers, Alumni and Parents.

From the feedback obtained A.Y. 2020-21 it was felt by the stakeholders that,

- The latest syllabus is very vast taking into consideration teaching hrs. available.
- MBA Students lack employment ready skills.
- Latest online working tools & technologies need to introduce in the syllabus.
- Students stated that, industrial interaction at local and outside of the state needs to be done frequently.
- Faculty sated that, latest happenings and case studies should be incorporated in the syllabus.
- Major and Minor specialization creating confusion.
- Dissertation also needed for 4th Semester.

Action Taken by the Institution:

- 1. Major concepts of the units need to be focused during classes and remaining concepts can be given to the students as an assignment.
- 2. Reskilling students with STEM based courses which provide specialised skills is the need of the hour. Non-engineering graduate students have to be focused more to improve their skills.
- 3. The Institute level and Skill Based courses are approved by Advisory Board and CDC of the Institute.
- 4. To have strong tie-up with various in the industries in the nearby locations to improve interaction between academia and industrial sector.
- 5. The teachers and students are encouraged to use latest MS Excel, SPSS and R software for their research and allied work.
- 6. Academic coordinator would take separate session on syllabus introduction.

Minutes of the Meeting:


