




Duties & Responsibilities :

- 1) Aligning Internal Examination with University Syllabus
- 2) Decisions regarding special, alternative arrangements that can be made at the request of the student;
- 3) Intervention in case of a disturbance of order during an examination.
- 4) Designate examiners to hold tests and preliminary examinations, and determine the results;
- 5) Decide whether a test should be taken orally, in writing or otherwise;
- 6) Grant exemptions from one or more preliminary examinations;
- 7) Decide whether a supplementary examination of the knowledge and skills of a student is necessary;
- 8) Deciding the Concurrent Evaluation Parameters and collecting Subject wise Student Progress Report
- 9) Issue the degree certificate and supplements after the Board of the University has authorized this.
