


Academic Year 2022-23

Interpretation: The above graph states that, 66% boys and 34% girls have submitted this SSS.


2. Class of Respondents

3. Syllabus Completion


Percentage of Syllabus Completed

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 125 responses



5. Communication made by Teachers


3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 125 responses

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as $^{\rm 125\,responses}$



7. Fairness in Internal Evaluation


5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 125 responses

6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 125 responses









9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. 125 responses





13. Follow-up for assigned task taken by Mentor


11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you. 125 responses

12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications 125 responses





13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.



14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.



17. The Institute takes efforts in mentoring, review and continuous quality improvement of teaching learning process


15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.



19. Teachers Encourage to Participate in Extra Curricular Activities


17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.



20. Percentage of teachers using ICT


19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while 125 responses
