## Memorandum of Understanding for Academic Cooperation

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MoU') is entered into on this the 1<sup>th</sup> day of Feb, 2023 by and between.

SECAB Institute of Engineering and Technology, Vijayapur (SECAB) and Anekant Education Society's Anekant Institute of Management Studies (AIMS), Baramati recognize their strengths in research and education in one or more disciplines of science engineering, management and social sciences, and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation.

SECAB and AIMS therefore agree to establish a programme for academic cooperation in theareas of mutual interest, and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding (MoU).

#### A. Objectives

The goal is to foster collaboration, provide opportunity for global experience, and to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best effort, mutual benefit, and frequent interactions. SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati agree:

- a) To exchange information on research and educational programmes
- b) To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their ducational and research programmes

- c) To jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest andto invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- d) To jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite ach other's faculty to participate therein.
- e) To jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- f) To exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students at Undergraduate, Graduate and Doctoral levels forlimited periods of time for purpose of education and /or research.

SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati further agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activityidentified above will be separately determined and agreed upon by the two institutions. These termsshall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s)responsible for its implementation, etc.

### B. Joint Sponsored Research, Development and Consulting

SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institutionto participate in research or development programmes. The terms and conditions for suchparticipation will be worked out by mutual agreement between SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati SVU will also offer opportunity of qualification up-gradation for the faculty members of AIMS Baramati on subsidised fees.

#### C.Exchange of Faculty, Scientists and Staff

SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati agree to encourage collaboration between faculty and scientists from the twoinstitutions. Specifically, institutions will encourage members of their faculties to undertake shortvisits to, or take up fixedterm visiting assignments at, each other's institution as per the existing norms. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment, including those concerning

Notwithstanding the above, SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati will examine ways to identify financial resourcesto fund international travel by their faculty/scientists/students.

#### D.Student Exchange

SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati agree that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below. Ahome institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student, and from wherehe/she is expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for abrief period of time to undertake a pre-determined programme of study or research.

- a) An exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and thehost institution.
- b) An exchange student will continue to be treated as full-time student at his/her home institution.
- c) An exchange student will be considered as full-time "exchange" student at the host institution.
- d) His/her programme of study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultationbetween his/her academic advisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academicadvisor identified by the host institution.
- e) The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module,award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.
- f) The home institution may award to the exchange student credits earned at a host institution, but only after the home institution has established correspondence between courses taken at the host institution vis-a-vis those offered at the home institution.

g) If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will BAR evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research, and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out.

- h) If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the home institution will take note of theperformance evaluation and the technical report, and take steps in accordance with its ownprocedures.
- i) SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati agree to provide suitable accommodation and living expenses for student exchange on mutual agreed terms and conditions.
- j) To avail travel expenses, students can apply for existing funding programs at their respectivehome universities.
- **k)** The exchange students will pay tuition and other fees at their home institution.

### E. Exchange of Scientific and Technical Material

SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati will exchange information on research and educational programmes andteaching/learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes. Further, SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati agree to explore ways to share teaching/learning material, and otherrelevant literature, while respecting each other's intellectual property and other rights.

#### F. Joint Conferences, workshops and short-term courses

SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for suchparticipation will be worked out by mutual agreement between SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati.

#### G. Intellectual Property

SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, theintellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-

by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid downIPR policies of the two institutions.

#### H. Co-ordination

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee, consisting of (a) Dean, SU Pilani, or his/her nominee, (b) Principal, AIMS Baramati, or his/her nominee, (c) Programme coordinator from the side of SU Pilani, and (d) Programme Coordinator from the side of AIMS Baramati, will periodically review andidentify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

# I. Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for Three years, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution three months in advance. Once terminated, neither SECAB, Vijayapurn or AIMS Baramati will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.
