(hereafter referred to as the Parties);

Both the parties are desiring to strengthen bilateral relations in the field of higher education by imparting advance education and 'Peer Think and Share' (PTS) activities;

Taking cognizance of the profound impact of higher education on cultural, economic and social development,

Recognizing the greater linkages between both the Paules in the field of education would be beneficial;

Consolidating upon the existing association between the two Parties since inception;

Pursuant to the prevailing needs, and norms in their respective campuses;

Have both the parties agreed as follows;

This Linkage agreement stands valid for five years and may be renewed with mutual consent.



#### Article I

### **Objective**

The objective of this Linkage agreement is to develop educational cooperation on the basis of reciprocity, mutual benefit, and to promote innovative mindset, skill development, and entrepreneurship among rural student community in particular and in general affiliated to either parties.

#### **Article II**

## **Areas of Cooperation**

The Parties shall encourage, as appropriate the development of contacts and cooperation. These may include all or some of the following activities:

- Exchange of guidance and expertise On Issues relating to quality enhancement in higher education and Research Knowhow;
- Organizing Training Programs concerning Business Skills, Life Skills, and Technical Skills;
- Organizing Joint Programs on the theme of Academic Conclave;
- Exchange of Academic Staff and students on innovative platforms viz. startups, incubation and entrepreneurship development;
- Exchange of faculty and staff members in Events;
- Facilitate Industrial Visits;
- Exploring the possibilities of conducting Short Term Certificate Courses;
- Facilitate internship programs for practical learning;
- Promote interdisciplinary Learning and Research in respective organizations;
- Providing Mutual assistance in the field of Library Resource Sharing,
   Computerization, etc.;
- Any other activity as agreed upon by the Parties in writing.

### Article III

## **Executive Responsibilities**

As per the agreement, the Parties shall designate appropriate individuals, resources for smooth conduct of activities identified therein;

## Article IV Implementation

The implementation of cooperation activities within the terms of this Linkage agreement shall be the subject of specific arrangements concluded between the parties on the basis of and within the provision of present Linkage agreement. However, at least two sessions in the Academic Year need to be taken by Mentor with consent of Mentee and vice versa.

## Article V Financial Arrangements

Looking to the modern education scenario; in fact indeed it is win win situation for both, the parties have agreed to enhance skill, talent, etc. of student by virtue of this Linkage agreement. Both shall deliver the activities within their full intellectual strength and Mentee shall make the necessary arrangements in full shape.

#### **Article VI**

## **Intellectual Property Rights**

Any result of activities made under this Linkage agreement shall be subject to the rules and regulations concerning protection of intellectual property rights in the respective organizations.

### Article VII

## Joint Working Group

- i) The Parties shall establish a Joint Working Group to facilitate, monitor and review the implementation of this Linkage agreement.
- ii) Such Joint Working Group as mentioned above shall be co-chaired by a representative each of either organization.
- iii) In certain circumstances where the meeting cannot be held, mutual consultations and exchange documents shall be made through electronic media *in lieu* of such meeting.

## **Article VIII**

### **Amendment**

Either Party may request in writing for a revision of or amendment (if any) to this Linkage agreement. Such revision or amendment shall come into effect on such a date as may be determined by both parties and shall form an integral part of this Linkage agreement.



#### **Article IX**

Lahori (Director), (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

#### WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

- First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest.
- E) The Second Party is a Higher Educational Institution, founded in 2011
- F) The Second Party through its management profession has a vision to build young skilled workforce in rural by up skilling, providing corporate and industry exposure to the aspiring engineers for their continuous professional development. Now collaborating with institutions through 'Cooperation in Higher Education' initiative in colleges across Maharashtra.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

#### **CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION**

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.

- 2.10 There is no financial commitment on the part of the both the parties. The parties to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.
- 2.11 If during the operation of the MOU, circumstances may arise which call for alteration/modification to this MOU, such alteration/modification shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon inwriting. Such changes will be formalized in writing as an 'Addendum' to this MOU. Any changes/amendments to this MOU not in conformance to this section shall be deemed to be void-ab-initio.

### **CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-

how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

#### **CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY**

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid for until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period either Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU



- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest;
- E) NextGen Education Foundation-, the Second Party is engaged in Business, Manufacturing, Skill Development, Education and R&D Services in the fields of -Industry 4.0 ,ERP ,Data Science, Artificial Intelligence, Business Intelligence, Business Analytics - - and related fields.
- F) Give related information, its branches, and dimensional information about the industry concerned with whom the MoU is sworn.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS Mou, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:



# CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Anekant Institute of Management Studies and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

# CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

The said MoU is the expansion and foundation of code of conduct for the NextGen-AIMS Center of Excellence (NACOE). - 2.8 Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the identified stakeholders of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements. Both parties agree jointly to utilize each-others resources, faculty, alumni, and students to organize and deliver guest sessions, and seminars with pre-communicated considerations (role, Schedule, Coverage, duration, financial implications, etc.).
- FDP and SDP: Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting industrial exposure/ training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available. Both parties agree jointly to utilize each-others resources, faculty, alumni, students to organize and deliver Faculty Development Programs (FDPs), Student Development Programs (SDP), as well as Industrial training with pre-communicated consideration (role, Schedule, Coverage, duration, financial implications, etc.).



# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered into on 18<sup>th</sup> June 2022 (Saturday), A. Y. 2021-22

#### BETWEEN

#### **AND**

Rotary Club of Baramati represented herein by Mr. Sanjay Prabhakar Dudhal, President, Rotary Club Of Baramati [Rotary Year 2021-22 Rid 3131 Club No. 15488], (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", organization which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors—in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

#### WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named: Anekant Institute of Management Studies (AIMS), Baramati
- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and establish Center of Excellence to channelize their efforts on cooperation within area of Social Work Projects, Skills Based Training, Education and Research, Consultancy.
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest;
- Rotary Club of Baramati, the Second Party is the Rotary Foundation helps Rotary members to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace by improving health, providing quality education, improving the environment, and alleviating poverty.

# NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS: CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the AIMS, Baramati and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the capabilities of the faculty, students, and alumni of First Party providing significant inputs to them in collaborating on life-changing & sustainable social projects of the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

## CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 **Student Centric:** The faculty members, Alumni, and budding MBA graduates from the institutions could play a key role in social work and transformational projects. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their social sensitivities, skills and knowledge.
- Establishment of Activity Based Rotary Club on Campus: Both the parties may agree to establish and support for the future social endeavors of Collaborative Learning, Research, Entrepreneurship, Incubation, Industry Connect, Placement Support, Certification Courses, SDP, FDP, MDP, Conferences, seminars, workshops, Colloquiums, Consultancies, and other activities with mutual agreement time-to-time, in the premises of either parties with ICT and Resources support. The said MoU is the foundation & expansion of Rotary Club Baramati. The formal Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) shall be discussed and finalized through mutual agreement on the same by parties.

- 2.3 Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology, evaluation, and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the social/ cultural and industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.4 Learning Programs & Visits: Organization and Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest developments / requirements of the society; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its member groups and also involve in Training/Learning Programs for the First Party. This exposure provided to students and faculty members through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth and competitive transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its facilities and community infrastructures for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party, and vice-versa.
- 2.5 **Internships and Placement of Students:** Second Party will actively engage to assist the delivery of the Internship for faculty and students and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs, as per AICTE internship Policy.
- 2.6 Research, Innovation and Consultancy: Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research, innovation and consultancy activities in the fields of Social Work, Community based Cultural engagements and related fields.
- 2.7 **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to train the faculty, resources, alumni, and students of First Party on the emerging skills in order to bridge the competency gap and make them industry-ready. Skill based training on 360 degree Personality Development and Social Entrepreneurship.
- Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the identified stakeholders of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements. Both parties agree jointly to utilize each-others resources, faculty, alumni, and students to organize and deliver guest sessions, and seminars with pre-communicated considerations (role, Schedule, Coverage, duration, financial implications, etc.).
- FDP and SDP: Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting industrial exposure/ training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available. Both parties agree jointly to utilize each-others resources, faculty, alumni, students to organize and deliver Faculty Development Programs (FDPs), Student Development Programs (SDP), as well as Industrial training with pre-communicated consideration (role, Schedule, Coverage, duration, financial implications, etc.).
- Approach to External Finding Agencies: Either party can apply for the external Governmental/ non-Governmental funding agencies (SPPU, DST, AICTE, etc.), and seek assistance from other party, on pre-communicated and mutually agreed terms and conditions, the separate definite document shall prepare with all consideration. (Role, Schedule, Covernment)

- 2.11 **Permissions:** Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein.
- 2.12 **No Financial Commitment:** There is no financial commitment on the part of the AIMS Baramati the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU, and vice versa. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

## **CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

#### **CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY**

4.1 To begin with, both the parties agree to sign the MoU for 3 years. This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

# **CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES**

It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party. Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Baramati city.

# 5.2 Commencement, Duration, and Termination

This Linkage agreement shall enter into force on the date of its signing for three years. This Linkage agreement shall remain in force by mutual consent, unless either Party notifies in writing of its intention to terminate this Linkage agreement two months in advance or existence of either party.

Any natural calamities may also cease this Linkage agreement.



# H. Co-ordination

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee, consisting of (a) Dean, SU Pilani, or his/her nominee, (b) Principal, AIMS Baramati, or his/her nominee, (c) Programme coordinator from the side of SU Pilani, and (d) Programme Coordinator from the side of AIMS Baramati, will periodically review andidentify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

# I. Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for Three years, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution three months in advance. Once terminated, neither SECAB, Vijayapurn or AIMS Baramati will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, SECAB, Vijayapur and AIMS Baramati will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.







#### **Objective**

- iii) Organizing Joint Programs;
- iv) Exchange of Academic Staff;
- v) Exchange of students;
- vi) Twinning arrangements between Industry and our Sister concerns;
- vii) Facilitate Industrial Visits;
- viii) Exploring the possibilities of conducting Short Term Certificate Courses;
- ix) Facilitate internship programs for practical learning;
- x) Promote interdisciplinary Learning and Research in respective educational Institutes:
- xi) Providing scholarships for higher education;
- xii) Providing Mutual assistance in the field of Library Resource Sharing, Computerization, etc.;
- xiii) Any other activity as agreed upon by the Parties in writing.

## Article III Executive Responsibilities

As per the agreement, the Parties shall designate appropriate individuals, resources for smooth conduct of activities identified therein;

## Article IV Implementation

The implementation of cooperation activities within the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be the subject of specific arrangements concluded between the parties on the basis of and within the provision of present Memorandum of Understanding. However, at least two sessions in the Academic Year need to be taken by Mentor with consent of Mentee and vice versa.

#### Article V Financial Arrangements

To service

Looking to the modern education scenario; in fact indeed it is win win situation for both, the parties have agreed to enhance skill, talent, etc. of student by virtue of this Memorandum of Understanding. Both shall deliver the activities within their full intellectual strength and Mentee shall make the necessary arrangements in full shape.

#### Article VI Intellectual Property Rights

Any result of activities made under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be subject to the rules and regulations concerning protection of intellectual property rights in the respective organizations.

## Article VII Joint Working Group

- i) The Parties shall establish a Joint Working Group to facilitate, monitor and review the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding.
- ii) Such Joint Working Group as mentioned above shall be co-chaired by a representative each of either organization.
- iii) In certain circumstances where the meeting cannot be held, mutual consultations and exchange documents shall be made through electronic media *in lieu* of such meeting.

#### Article VIII Amendment

Either Party may request in writing for a revision of or amendment (if any) to this Memorandum of Understanding. Such revision or amendment shall come into effect on such a date as may be determined by both parties and shall form an integral part of this Memorandum of Understanding.

#### Article IX Relinquish

Always it is open to revamp this Memorandum of Understanding in the interest of both the parties and students, concerning to the interpretation of implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding through consultation and negotiation by the parties. Even if both the parties desire to withdraw this Memorandum of Understanding, they can do so, by due process through mutual understanding.

## Article X Commencement, Duration, and Termination

 This Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the date of its signing for Ten years.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force by mutual consent, unless either Party notifies in writing of its intention to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding six months in advance or existence of either party.

iii) Any natural calamities may also cease this Memorandum of Understanding.
