ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

At Anekant Institute of Management Studies (AIMS), we are dedicated to high standards of hospitality and advocate environmentally sustainable academic operations. Our aim is to positively impact the communities in which we operate through energy efficient practices and environmental education. In an effort to adopt environmentally conscious attitudes, we have established several measures with which we can preserve our natural resources and seek to prevent pollution.

Objectives:

- 1. Educate, educate, and train all staff in environmental issues to instill a sense of environmental responsibility.
- 2. Assess environmental impact of all our activities and products, and seek to eliminate any that pose harm to the environment when economically and operationally practical.
- 3. Reduce waste going to the landfill by minimizing amount of waste produced, using materials when possible, and recycling other wastes.
- 4. Purchase and use environmentally responsible (recyclable, refurbished, etc.) products & material from environmentally responsible suppliers.
- 5. Encourage staff to conserve the need for renewable energy supplies.
- 6. Implement the following methods to improve energy usage:
 - 1. Upgrade Institute lighting to include occupancy sensors that ensure light is being utilized only when necessary.
 - 2. Use Energy Star appliances as replacements of appliances when needed.
 - 3. Use low flow aerators in sinks and showerheads as a means of conserving water.
- 7. Take measures to decrease harmful emissions.
- 8. Communicate our environmental policy to the public to promote their support.
- 9. Comply with environmental legislation, and strive to follow best practices.
- 10. Seek continuous advancement by monitoring progress and remaining proactive. The environmental policy and its objectives will be periodically reviewed.


ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Guidelines/Regulations for Waste Management

All waste facilities within the Institute premises are required to adhere to the following guidelines to ensure proper waste management and the health of the community.

1. All waste generated inside the Institute for any kind of solid waste inside the campus. Don't throw any other material inside the Institute premises, please refer to the guidelines.
2. Don't throw the waste/water plastic waste inside the campus. For waste of computer accessories, please refer to the guidelines. Collection dust bins to dispose the waste.
3. Students and staff members are informed to dispose the waste like e-waste, like desktop, monitor, keyboard, mouse, and other waste like computer accessories in a waste collection bin.
4. Don't take lunch inside the classroom. During events all students should properly dispose the plastic plates, glasses, disposable material and other waste.
5. Please don't throw food in specially. Prohibited to eat outside.
