





Centralized Admission Process (CAP)

- 4. Aspiring Candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria as notified by the Government and specified by the appropriate authority, from time to time, shall apply to the Director of the Institute for admission at the Institution level.
- 5. The institute, as specified by the appropriate authority, will fill the seats in the NRI Quota, based on the Merit list prepared and published by the Competent Authority.
- 6. The institute shall give admission to the applicants on the basis of their inter-se merit derived from Merit list based on the basis of CET prepared by the procedure specified in rule 8(4) of Admission Act.
- 7. The institution shall prepare and display the Inter-Se merit lists of the Candidates to be filled in at the institution level, in the Institutional Quota with the vacant seats after CAP, on the notice board and shall publish the same on the website of the institution
- 8. All the admissions and cancelations shall be updated immediately through online system.


